- $(1) For paragraph 195 AT(2A) \qquad (c) of the Act, the following information and particulars are prescribed for inclusion in an otice to an author in relation to an artist ic work that is affixed to or form spart of abuilding:$
 - (a)thedateofthenotice;
 - (b)thename(ifany)andaddressofthebuilding;
 - (c)abriefdescriptionoftheworkanditslocationinoronthebuilding;
 - (d)thenameandaddressoftheownerof thebuilding;
- (e)theowner's contact details during business hours, including work telephone and facsimile numbers, and email address (if a vailable);
- (f)thenameofthepersonwhocanprovidetheauthorwithaccesstothebuildingorthe work,orboth, asapplicable,andthatperson'scontactdetails;
- (g)thebusinesshoursduringwhichtheauthormayreasonablyhaveaccesstothe buildingortothework,orboth,asapplicable;
- (h)inrelationtoachangeinthebuilding(otherthanbyreasonofrelo cation, demolitionordestruction),abriefdescriptionofthechangeandtheextent(ifany)towhich theworkislikelytobeaffected;
- (i)inrelationtotherelocationofthebuilding,abriefdescriptionoftheplaceandform oftherelocation,andt heextenttowhichtheworkislikelytobeaffected.
- (2)Forparagraph195AT(3A) (c)oftheAct,thefollowinginformationandparticulars are prescribed for inclusion in an otice to an authorin relation to a building, or to any plans or instruction su sed in the construction of the building or apart of the building:
 - (a)thedateofthenotice;
 - (b)thename(ifany)andaddressofthebuilding;
 - (c)thenameandaddressoftheownerofthebuilding;
- (*d*)theowner'scontactdetailsduringbusinesshou rs,includingworktelephoneand facsimilenumbers,andemailaddress(ifavailable);
- (e)thenameofthepersonwhocanprovidetheauthorwithaccesstothebuildingand that person's contact details;
- (f)thebusinesshoursduringwhichtheauthormay reasonablyhaveaccesstothe building;
- (g) in relation to a change in the building (other than by reason of relocation, demolition or destruction), a brief description of the change and the extent (if any) to which the building is likely to be affected;



- (h) in relation to the relocation of the building, a brief description of the place and form of the relocation and the extent to which the building is likely to be affected.
- (3)Forparagraph195AT(4B) (c)oftheAct,thefollowinginformationandparti culars are prescribed for inclusionina notice to an authorin relation to the removal or relocation of a moveable artistic worksituated at a place that is accessible to the public:
 - (a) thedateofthenotice;
 - (b)abriefdescriptionofthemoveablear tisticwork;
- (c) the address of the place or description of the location, at which the move ablear tistic work may be accessed;
 - (d)thenameandaddressoftheremoverofthemoveableartisticwork;
- (e)theremover's contact details during business hours including work telephone and facsimile numbers, and email address (if a vailable);
- (f)ifnecessary,thenameofthepersonwhocanprovidetheauthorwithaccesstothe placeandthemoveableartisticwork,asapplicable,andthatperson'scontactdetai ls;
- (g)ifnecessary,thebusinesshoursduringwhichtheauthormayreasonablyhave accesstotheplaceandtothemoveableartisticwork;
- (h)ifthemoveableartisticworkistobepermanentlyremovedorrelocated,theaddress ordescriptionofthenew locationorstoragelocation(ifnotopentothepublic)ofthe moveableartisticwork;
- (i) if the removal or relocation of the move able artistic work will result in a change of ownership in the work, then a mean daddress of the new owner.
 - (4)Inthisr egulation, *author* includes a person representing the author.

- (3)Forparagraphs195AT (2A) (a),(3A) (a) and (4B) (a) of the Act, the giving of a notice to an author, or person representing the author, (addressee) must be:
 - (a)byregisteredpost;or
- (b) by a courier service that provides means of confirming delivery to, or receipt by, the addressee.
