This Decree establishes the rate of the resale right on graphic and plastic works of art. It grants public and ministerial officials the authority to engage in the sale of a graphic or plastic work of art and to pay this royalty directly to the Burkina Copyright Bureau. It also sets out the penalties provided for by law in the event of non-compliance.
