Brief description of the notified legal text

Regulation No. 137 of 15 July 1993 (now repealed) adopted an Ordinance on industrial property representatives. The Ordinance was superseded/repealed by Reg. No. 161 of 2017, which was in turn repealed on 3 June 2022 by Regulation 102. The relevant provisions have been incorporated in the Act on patents and registration of utility models in Chapter eight "b" Industrial property representatives.
