Said text was proposed by the Brazilian Congress and concerns mainly changes to agricultural fees and taxes. Nevertheless, Article 27 amends the Plant Variety Protection Law, including by adding one exception to the plant-breeders rights and by adding a provision which exempts small farmers from paying fees when applying for protection.
