Conditions for obtaining protection; scope of protection; maximum term of protection; right to continued use and right to parallel use; deferment of publication in lieu of deposit under sealed cover; continuation of the examination procedure in the event of an applicant's failure to meet a deadline instead of reinstatement under the law in force at that time; regulation on the standing of the licensee.

Articles 18 and 19.1:

- Amendment concerning representation in Switzerland when the domicile is abroad. Article 19.1 is purely editorial.
