Brief description of the notified legal text

This Ordinance specifies the types of appellation which may be registered, the protection afforded to them, registration procedures and control requirements: definitions of registered appellation of origin and protected geographical indication; generic names; registration procedure (persons entitled to file applications for registration, content of the application, specifications, decision, opposition, registration and publication, etc.); control, etc.

Most recent amendments concerning GIs:

Art. 5; 17, para. 4b; para. 5; 18, para. 1bis; 19; 19a, para. 1; 23a:

- Persons entitled to file applications for registration: for plant products, only significant producers are taken into account; registered appellation of origin and protected geographical indication products as ingredients or components of processed products; indication of certification body; requirements relating to certification bodies.

Art. 17, para. 2e; 21a, para. 4: - Repealed on 11 November 2020.
