Decree having Force of Law No. 30 (enacted in 2005) consolidated and systematized the text of Decree having Force of Law No. 213 (enacted in 1953), which establishes the National Customs Ordinance. This decree provides for audit functions, enforcement powers and proceedings of the National Customs.
