Brief description of the notified legal text

The purpose of this Law is to amend various aspects of the customs legislation contained in the Customs Order and other legal texts by introducing improvements to customs processes to simplify the development of foreign trade operations. To that end, the withdrawal of goods against a guarantee of customs levies is authorized and the Customs Warehousing Destination is established. The temporary admission regime is refined; express shipments are regulated under the SAFE initiative of the World Customs Organization; the position of authorized economic operator is incorporated into national legislation; and the National Customs Service is empowered to approve applications from persons with disabilities under the law that grants duty-free allowances for vehicle imports to such persons and to non-profit legal persons in the field of disability.
