<p>This law governs national monuments and establishes the National Monuments Council to protect them. The law designates historic monuments, public monuments and archaeological and palaeontological monuments. It also governs the conservation of the environmental characteristics of certain places or populations home to archaeological ruins or to ruins and buildings declared to be historic monuments, in addition to sites declared to be nature and research reserves. Lastly, the law governs the system for exchanging and loaning collections among State museums overseen by the National Cultural Heritage Service and between these museums and privately owned museums and scientific institutions.</p>
