Decree No. 24611-J, which protects, by the mere fact of its creation, the rights in all creative works, of an original nature, whether literary or artistic, regardless of genre, form of expression, merit or purpose. Related rights on copyright are also protected. Amended by Executive Decrees No. 26882-J of 20 April 1998, No. 34904 of 21 November 2008, No. 36014-MP-COMEX-J of 3 May 2010 and No. 37417 of 1 November 2012. This is therefore a consolidated and amended version of Executive Decree No. 24611-J.
