Brief description of the notified legal text

The notified text sets out the procedures applicable to the protection of undisclosed information, particularly information that is supplied to the competent authorities for the purpose of registering new pharmaceutical or agrochemical products. It also regulates the procedures enabling the Industrial Property Registry to discharge its functions and responsibilities when a holder of undisclosed information decides to entrust it with such information.
