Brief description of the notified legal text

The regulation establishes a procedure to limit liability for internet service providers for copyright infringements by users. According to this procedure, a provider must inform the owner of the possible infringement, who must respond, and on the basis of its own capabilities, the provider must remove the potentially infringing material.
