Pursuant to Section 34 subsection 2 and Section 35 subsection 2 no. 2 of the Patent Law, which were reformulated by Article 2 of the Law of 16 July 1998 (Federal Law Gazette I p. 1827), and pursuant to Section 4 subsection 2 and Section 4a subsection 2 no. 2 of the Utility Model Law, which were inserted by Article 3 of the Law of 16 July 1998 (Federal Law Gazette I p. 1827), notification is hereby made that

Baden-Württemberg Land Trading Office  
– Patent Information Centre –, Stuttgart,

shall be designated a Patent Information Centre as from 9 October 2000 for the purpose of Section 34 subsection 2 and Section 35 subsection 2 no. 2 of the Patent Law, Section 4 subsection 2 and Section 4a subsection 2 no. 2 of the Utility Model Law as well as Article II Section 4 of the Law on International Patent Treaties of 21 June 1976 (Federal Law Gazette 1976 Part II p. 649), as last amended by Article 6 of the Law of 16 July 1998 (Federal Law Gazette I p. 1827).

The President of the German Patent and Trade Mark Office shall publish further details on the acceptance of applications in the Journal for Patents, Trade Marks and Designs.
