Order No. 2021-1518 amends the provisions of the Intellectual Property Code to introduce mandatory exceptions to copyright in order to allow for text and data mining, digital uses of works for the purpose of illustration for teaching, and the preservation of cultural heritage. The provisions expand access to works through collective licensing.
