This Protocol establishes the specific status to be enjoyed by the future Unified Patent Court, as an international institution, in French territory. The Protocol provides for the principles of inviolability of the Court's premises, archives and documents; immunity and freedom of movement for representatives of the States Parties in the exercise of their official missions; exemption from taxes, under certain circumstances, for the Court; and immunity and privileges for judges and staff of the Court.
