Brief description of the notified legal text

This decree introduces a system for provisional applications for patents that allows the deferred submission of some documents provided as part of a patent application; it also allows for a period of 12 months to be granted for the submission of the request to convert the provisional application to a patent application or a utility certificate application. The decree also specifies the terms for converting a utility certificate to a patent.
