Brief description of the notified legal text

Decree No. 2021-1369 specifies the methods for assessing the significant quantity of protected works or objects mentioned in Article L. 137-1 of the Intellectual Property Code for the purposes of determining the online content-sharing service providers defined in this Article. The Decree also defines the rules of procedure to be applied when a claim is brought to the High Authority for the dissemination of works and the protection of rights on the internet by a user or a holder of copyright or related rights in disputes over the action taken by an online content-sharing service provider in response to a complaint from a user regarding the disabling or removal of uploaded works.
