Brief description of the notified legal text

These Rules revoke the Registered Design (Fees) (No. 2) Rules 1995. The also modify a number of fees as follows:

- (a) the additional fee for extensions of time not exceeding one month is reduced from £24 to no fee (Form 9A);
- (b) the fee for entries concerning change of proprietorship, mortgagee or licensee (Form 12A) is reduced from £50 to no fee;
- (c) the fee for inspection of the register in person and a request for information are both reduced from $\pounds 5$ to no fee.
