Brief description of the notified legal text		
The Act introduces provisions imposing obligations on internet service providers aimed at reducing online infringement of copyright. It also amends the law on copyright and performers' property rights by increasing penalties for some forms of copyright infringement and performers' property rights infringement.		
Section 43 amends the Public Lending Right Act 1979 and the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 to allow inclusion of non-print formats (audio-books and e-books) in the public lending right payment regime.		
Amended the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 in relation to penalties relating to infringing articles or illicit recordings.		
Amended the Communications Act 2003 in relation to online infringement of copyright and obligations of internet service providers.
