The Order amends the Designs (Convention Countries) Order 2007 under powers conferred by sections 13(1) and 37(5) of the Registered Designs Act 1949 to fulfil the international obligations of the UK as a Member of the World Trade Organization ('WTO'). Samoa became a member of the WTO on the 10 May 2012 and Vanuatu on 24 August 2012. This Order declares that Samoa and Vanuatu are convention countries for the purposes of the Registered Designs Act 1949.
