Brief description of the notified legal text

The Order amends the Trade Marks (International Registration) Order 2008 (SI 2008/2206). The requirement to register in the supplementary register any restriction of the goods and services covered by a request for extension is removed. The fee to request an extension of time under the Trade Marks Rules 2008 (SI 2008/1797) as applied to international trade marks is increased from £50 to £100.
