Brief description of the notified legal text

These Regulations amend the Design Right (Semiconductor Topographies) Regulations 1989, which modify the application of Part 3 (design right) of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 to semiconductor topographies and give effect to the Council Decision of 22 December 1994 on the extension of the legal protection of topographies of semiconductor products to persons from a member of the World Trade Organization (94/824/EC). The Regulations update the Schedule to the 1989 Regulations to take account of the accession to TRIPS of Vietnam, Tonga and Ukraine.
