The Regulations amend the Community Trade Mark Regulations 1996. The amendments substitute references to the Trade Mark Rules 1994 (now revoked) with references to the Trade Mark Rules 2000 (SI 2000/136 as amended by SI 2001/3832 and SI 2004/947). The Regulations also update the 1996 Regulations in line with the regime under the Trade Marks Rules 2000.
