Brief description of the notified legal text

This instrument makes changes to the Patents Rules 2007, which set out procedural and administrative requirements applying to patents and patent applications. The changes are necessary to set out the scope of the newly expanded Patent Opinions Service, and to specify the period within which outstanding fees must be paid following the restoration of a previously revoked European patent (UK). This instrument also makes a minor clarification to a rule relating to the deadline for filing a new patent application based upon material contained in an earlier application.
