This Order amends the Copyright and Performances (Application to Other Countries) Order 2016 (SI 2016/2019), which, along with the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988, provides copyright and rights in performances to foreign nationals. This Order extends further protections to certain countries' nationals in order to implement recent UK free-trade agreements and in response to countries recently joining the WIPO Performances and Phonograms Treaty.
