## UNITED KINGDOM DESIGNS (PROTECTION)

(Gold Coast)

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PTOTECTION IN THE GOLD COAST OF DESIGNS REGISTERED IN THE UNITED KINGDOM.

(Amended by 41 of 1949, s.2.)

Date of Commence-ment.

[9th November, 1928.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "United Kingdom Designs (Protection) Ordinance." (Substituted by 41 of 1949, s.3.)

Extension to the Gold Coast of privileges and rights enjoyed under 7 Edw.7, c.29 and 9 and 10 Geo.V. c.80.

2. Subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, the registered proprietor of any design registered in the United Kingdom under the Patents and Designs Acts, 1907 and 1919, or any act amending or substituted for those Acts, shall enjoy in the Gold Coast the like privileges and rights as though the Certificate of Registration in the United Kingdom had been issued with an extension to the Gold Coast. Protection of persons unintentionally infringing copyright in designs.

3. The registered proprietor of a design shall not be entitled to recover any damages in respect of any infringement of copyright in a design from any defendant who proves that at the date of infringement he was not aware nor had any reasonable means of making himself aware of the existence of the registration of the design:

Proviso.

Provided that nothing in this section shall affect any proceedings for an injunction.

Power to Court to declare that copyright in a design has not been acquired in the Gold Coast. 4. The Court shall have power upon the application of any person who alleges that his interests have been prejudicially affected, to declare that exclusive privileges and rights have not been acquired in the Gold Goast under the provisions of this Ordinance, upon any of the grounds upon which the United Kingdom registration might be cancelled under the law for the time being in force in the United Kingdom. Such grounds shall be deemed to include the publication of the designs in the Gold Coast prior to the date of registration of the design in the United Kingdom.
