

Copyright (Exception from Delivery of Books to certain Libraries) Regulations, 1964

(No. 181, of July 20, 1964)

1. — These Regulations may be cited as the Copyright (Exception from Delivery of Books to Certain Libraries) Regulations, 1964.
2. — These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1964.
3. — There shall be excepted from the provisions of subsection (1) of section 56 of the Copyright Act, 1963 (No. 10 of 1963), in regard to:
 - (a) the trustees of the National Library of Ireland;
 - (b) the authority having control of the Library of Trinity College, Dublin, and
 - (c) the respective authorities having control of the three constituent Colleges of the National University of Ireland and St. Patrick's College, Maynooth,publications of the following kinds, that is to say:
 - (i) trade advertisements,
 - (ii) trade cards,
 - (iii) trade catalogues,
 - (iv) trade circulars,
 - (v) trade coupons,
 - (vi) trade designs,
 - (vii) trade forms,
 - (viii) trade labels,
 - (ix) trade leaflets,
 - (x) trade plans,
 - (xi) trade posters,
 - (xii) trade price lists,
 - (xiii) trade prospectuses,
 - (xiv) trade show cards, and
 - (xv) trade wrappers.

These regulations specify publications exempted from the provisions of section 56 of the Copyright Act, 1963, which require publishers to deliver copies of books to certain libraries.
