INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL PROPERTY (PROTECTION) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1949.*

AN ACT TO REPEAL CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL
PROPERTY (PROTECTION) ACT, 1927. [21st December, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:—

1.—The following provisions of the Industrial and Commercial Property (Protection) Act, 1927 (No. 16 of 1927), are hereby repealed—

- (a) in subsection (1) of section 9, from the words “so however” to the end of the subsection, and
- (b) the Second Schedule.

2.—

(1) This Act may be cited as the Industrial and Commercial Property (Protection) (Amendment) Act, 1949.

(2) The Industrial and Commercial Property (Protection) Acts, 1927 to 1947, and this Act may be cited together as the Industrial and Commercial Property (Protection) Acts, 1927 to 1949.
