## Brief description of the notified legal text

This Order, which will apply from 1 January 2002, sets out the fee payable in euros upon filing of a request for a supplementary protection certificate at the Irish Patents Office. All payments in respect of this fee, made before 1 January 2002, that are due before the end of 2001, will be the subject of the legislation in force at the time of payment. Fees notified before the end of 2001, but due in 2002, may be paid in advance at the rate payable in 2002. All payments made on or after 1 January 2002 will be at the rates payable in 2002.
