These Regulations implement elements of the Copyright and Related Rights Act, 2000 (Act No. 28 of 2000). The Regulations prescribe the form of the notice, to be given at the time of seizure, to the owner, occupier or person in charge of the place where infringing copies, illicit recordings, protection-defeating devices or articles associated with making infringing copies or illicit recordings, as the case may be, are seized under Section 133 or Section 257 of the Copyright and Related Rights Act 2000.
