These Regulations prescribe libraries and archives for the purposes of certain exceptions relating to the copying of protected materials, as required by the relevant sections of the Copyright and Related Rights Act 2000 (No. 28 of 2000) and prescribe the conditions that must be met where certain exceptions of this nature are availed of.

Language(s) of notified legal text	English
Entry into force	1 January 2001; The Regulations were signed by the Minister of State at the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment on 15 December 2000, specifying that they will come into operation on 1 January 2001, other than Regulation 4 (a) and 6 (a). Regulation 4 (a) are specified as coming into operation on 1 April 2001.
