COURTS (ESTABLISHMENT AND CONSTITUTION) ACT, 1961 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDER, 1961.

The Government, in exercise of the power conferred on them by subsection (2) of [section 8](#) of the [Courts \(Establishment and Constitution\) Act, 1961](#) (No. 39 of 1961), hereby order as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the [Courts \(Establishment and Constitution\) Act, 1961](#) (Commencement) Order, 1961.
2. The [Courts \(Establishment and Constitution\) Act, 1961](#) (No. 39 of 1961), shall come into operation on the 29th day of September, 1961.
