This Act revises with amendments Part XIII of The Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 and The Maritime Jurisdiction Acts 1959 to 1988; provides for the establishment of a body to be known as The Sea-Fisheries Protection Authority, and to define its functions; to amend and extend The Fisheries Acts 1959 to 2003, The Mercantile Marine Act 1995, The Fishery Harbour Centres Act 1968, The Dumping at Sea Act 1996 and The Maritime Safety Act 2005; to amend or repeal certain enactments and provide for connected matters.
