Brief description of the notified legal text

The revised act is to expand the range of trademarks that can be registered. Under the new law, although trademarks that are similar to those already registered by others generally cannot be registered, they may be registered if there is the consent of the prior trademark right holder and no risk of confusion about the source.

In addition, in order to allow persons conducting business activities in their own name to use their name as a trademark, trademarks that include their names became registrable without the consent of others in certain cases.
