<p>This Law shall legitimize inventions as objects of industrial property, regulate the rights and duties of legal and natural persons with respect to inventions, and provide legal protection thereof. This Law shall apply to inventions, which are the object of a patent application filed or of a patent granted in accordance with the procedure set forth by this Law, of a patent application or a patent which are equated to them in accordance with the procedure set forth by this Law, and actions related to these patent applications or patents.</p>
