The Law regulates the activities of collecting societies, independent management companies and dependent management entities in the management of the rights of copyright and related rights holders in the collective interests of those copyright or related rights holders and establishes the procedure for monitoring the activities of collecting societies and special rules for the settlement of disputes.
