The following changes have been made to the Federal Criminal Code: Amendments to paragraph I of Article 426, and Article 429; Addition of paragraph III to Article 168 <i>bis</i> ; paragraph III to Article 424 <i>bis</i> ; paragraphs III and IV to Article 426; and Articles 427 <i>bis</i> , 427 <i>ter</i> , 427 <i>quater</i> and 427 <i>quinquies</i> .		
Penalties have been introduced for various infringements of copyright and related rights, including the following:		
i. the act of decrypting or decoding, or of providing goods and/or services that are used to decrypt or decode, encrypted program-carrying satellite or cable signals, without the authorization of the lawful distributor of the signals concerned;		
ii. the act of circumventing or evading, or of providing, for profit-making purposes, goods and/or services to circumvent technological protection measures used by producers of phonograms and performers, and authors of any work protected by copyright or related rights;		
iii. the act of engaging or participating in, without authorization and for profit-making purposes, the removal or alteration of rights-management information; and

iv. the act of recording, transmitting or copying, in full or in part, a protected cinematographic work, shown at a cinema or similar venue, without the authorization of the copyright or related rights holder.
