 - (2) This order comes into force 28 days after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- **2. New Schedules substituted**—The principal order is amended by revoking the First, Second, and Third Schedules, and substituting the Schedules set out in the Schedule of this order. *Price Code:* 7—*BY* Cl. 2


