**2 Appointment of date for repeal of Geographical Indications Act 1994**

Section 62 of the Geographical Indications (Wine and Spirits) Registration Act 2006 comes into force on 14 April 2008.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 14 April 2008, section 62 of the Geographical Indications (Wine and Spirits) Registration Act 2006 (the **2006 Act**). Section 62 repeals the Geographical Indications Act 1994 (which itself has never been brought into force). This order applies to section 62 of the 2006 Act only; the remainder of the 2006 Act has yet to be brought into force.
