Brief description of the notified legal text <p>The Commercial Court Law was officially approved by the royal decree No. M/93 dated on April 8, 2020 and published on 24/08/1441H (corresponding to 17 April 2020) in the Saudi Official gazette (Um Al-Quraa). The Law and its Implementing Regulation officially came into force 60 days from the date of publication.</p> <p>The provisions of the Commercial Court Law will govern:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">all disputes that fall within the jurisdiction of Commercial Courts; and the procedures of the Commercial Courts which include claims and violations arising from the implementation of intellectual property laws.</p>
