Brief description of the notified legal text

The Resolution approves the Procedure for acquisition and loss of the status of orphan works, phonograms, videograms and performances recorded therein, conditions for their authorized use and maintenance of the register, which defines:

- the institution that may initiate the granting of orphan works and (or) related rights status to copyright and (or) related rights objects and subsequently use orphan works and related rights objects:
- the list of sources for conducting a proper search for copyright and (or) related rights holders before status to granting orphan works, phonograms, videograms and performances recorded therein;

- the list of measures needing to be taken in case of identification of the subject of copyright and (or) related rights to establish his/her location (place of residence) before granting orphan status to works, phonograms, videograms and performances recorded therein;
- the procedure for filing and consideration of applications for granting orphan status to a work and/or phonogram, videogram and/or performance recorded therein and for losing orphan status to a work and/or phonogram, videogram and/or performance recorded therein;
- the time-limits for consideration of an application for the acquisition of orphan status by a work and/or phonogram, videogram and/or performance recorded therein, as well as an application for the loss of orphan status by a work and/or phonogram, videogram and/or performance recorded therein;
- the peculiarities of filing applications in the form of a paper or electronic document;
- issues related to the maintenance of the register of orphan works, in particular, the list of information to be recorded into the register; and
- regulation of the procedure for submitting a wanted application and taking a decision to publish or refuse to publish based on the results of the consideration of the wanted application.
