In compliance with the Prime Minister's Directive No. 11/CT-TTg dated 4 March 2020 regarding urgent tasks and measures to relieve business and production difficulties as well as assure social security in response to the Covid-19 pandemic, this Circular of Ministry of Finance provides that: from 26 May 2020 to end of 31 December 2020, payers shall pay 50% of the rates of charges specified in the section A of the Schedule of fees and charges for industrial property enclosed with Circular No. 263/2016/TT-BTC dated 14 November 2016.
