



MAINTENANCE AND PROMOTION OF COMPETITION AMENDMENT ACT NO. 96 OF 1987

[ASSENTED TO 13 OCTOBER, 1987]

[DATE OF COMMENCEMENT: 1 JANUARY, 1987]

ACT

To amend the Maintenance and Promotion of Competition Act, 1979, so as to substitute the definition of “Minister”; and to further determine the powers of the Minister of Economic Affairs and Technology to deal with restrictive practices, acquisitions and monopoly situations; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

1. Amends section 1 of the Maintenance and Promotion of Competition Act, No. 96 of 1979, by substituting the definition of “Minister”.

2. Amends section 14 (1) (c) of the Maintenance and Promotion of Competition Act, No. 96 of 1979, by substituting subparagraph (i).

3. Short title and commencement.—This Act shall be called the Maintenance and Promotion of Competition Amendment Act, 1987, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 1987.
